us know we need to get a vote on the full spend even though we voted on the budget in the past. Charlie Hurwitch asked if there was a variance in budget. Reg said no. Charlie Hurwitch feels good

In 2019, it was voted to discontinue this practice. Dave asked if there was any appetite to reconsider this decision given much has changed since then because of COVID.
